In medieval times, people believed that birds began choosing their mates on February 14th, which contributed to the holiday's romantic associations.


#### Flowers&romance



#### There is Valentine's Day CELEBRATED AROUND THE WORLD?

As February 14th approaches, people across the globe prepare to celebrate each country adds its unique, making Valentine's Day a truly global celebration.

In the United States, Valentine's Day is widely regarded as a commercial celebration, with people giving gifts such as chocolates, flowers, and cards to loved ones. This practice is similarly observed in Canada.

In countries like Colombia, El Dia del Amor y la Amistad (the Day of Love and Friendship) is a colorful celebration, not limited to couples but extending to friends and family as well. Participants draw names randomly, keeping their assigned friend a secret. Over a set period, usually a week, they anonymously give small gifts or sweets.

- Create Valentine's Day crafts or decorations together.


#### With Friends:

In Poland the only city booming with Valentine's day celebrations is Chelmno. One can expect special concerts, exhibisions and a whole themed market to take place on their arrival.






There is a country, where only girls give chocolate boxes for their lovers. Boys hand over presents a month later. It happens in Japan.





Draw a heart on a folded paper




